

PERMIT TO OPERATE OVERSIZE LOADS
ON COUNTY ROADS AND HIGHWAYS

The County of LaGrange, by and through its agents (“County”) hereby grants permission to _____ (“Permit Holder”) to operate oversized vehicles on County roads and highways upon the following conditions:

1. The maximum load size allowed by this permit shall not have a width greater than sixteen (16) feet and an overall length not greater than eighty (80) feet;
2. The oversized vehicle may be operated only between sunrise and sunset;
3. The Permit Holder to which this permit is granted shall present satisfactory evidence of the Permit Holder’s financial responsibility including proof that he has insurance coverage for any damages that may occur on County right-of-way or private property while moving oversized loads;
4. The oversized vehicle may not be operated during the existence of hazardous weather conditions such as fog, heavy rain or snow, etc., when visibility is limited to less than one-quarter (1/4) mile or during times when the steady wind velocity exceeds twenty-five (25) miles per hour;
5. The oversized vehicle is accompanied by the same number of distinctively marked escort vehicles as required by the State of Indiana Permit Agency.

The Permit Holder agrees that the Permit Holder shall be responsible for all utilities, traffic control, and any and all damages to road pavement and/or signs. Permit Holder agrees to indemnify and hold harmless, including reasonable attorney fees, said County for any and all loss, liability, damage or cost incurred due to Permit Holders use and access of county roads and highway for the operating of oversized loads.

The Permit Holder shall notify the LaGrange County Highway Department at least twenty-four (24) hours prior to moving oversized loads and identify which county roads and/or highways will be used.

This permit shall remain in effect for a period of twelve (12) months from the date of issuance. This permit, however, may be revoked or suspended by County for violation of any of the conditions of the permit as set forth above.
