

### Problem-Solving Court Coordinator

The LaGrange Superior Court is seeking a qualified candidate for the position of Drug Court Coordinator. The LaGrange Superior Court Drug Court was established in July of 2017. The qualified candidate will possess an advanced degree from an accredited university or college, two or more years in a substance abuse treatment setting or probation setting, two or more years in the criminal justice setting and will possess excellent written and oral presentation skills. The qualified candidate must also be willing to travel both in and out of state for purpose of training conferences, meetings and problem-solving court site visits. A current driver's license and proof of insurance is also required. If not already in compliance, the candidate must be willing to comply with the problem-solving court training requirements set forth in Section 12 of the Indiana Problem-Solving Court Rules within the first year of employment. This position reports directly to the LaGrange Superior Court Judge and is responsible for the coordination of services, case management for the participants, overseeing various aspects of the program and reporting as required to the judge and funding agencies. The position also requires public speaking to promote the missions, goals and objectives of the problem-solving court. A qualified candidate must be detail oriented and possess excellent organizational skills. Compensation for this position will be based upon experience, qualifications and the probation officer salary schedule developed by the Indiana Court Services.
