

POSITION OPENING – 911 DISPATCHER

The LaGrange County Sheriff's Department is currently accepting applications for the position of Full-Time 911 Dispatcher.

Interested persons may obtain an application at the LaGrange County Sheriff's Department located at 0875 S State Road 9 LaGrange, Indiana 46761 or online at www.lagrangecounty.org. Applications, with resumes, accepted through November 3rd, 2017.

Starting pay is currently \$16.11-\$16.61 per hour based on experience with pay increases after the successful completion of 13 week training program and then again after a year based on acceptable performance. LaGrange County 911 Dispatcher top pay is currently \$18.61 an hour.

Minimum Requirements for Employment:

Candidates must be at least 21 years old, be a US Citizen, must possess a high school diploma or GED, possess a valid driver's license, and not have any felony convictions.

Candidates for this position must also expect to undergo a background investigation that meets all local, state and federal requirements, as well as a voice stress examination, and drug screen.

Another minimum requirement for employment for a 911 dispatcher includes the completion of a comprehensive training program during the first several months of employment. This often includes classroom training and extensive, on-the-job training.
