COUNCIL FOR DRUG FREE LAGRANGE COUNTY

HIGHWAY – PURCHASE OF RIGHT-A-WAY EQUIPMENT

Mr. Aaron Fugate, Highway Supervisor, presented a quote from Agro Chem, Inc. for a 275 gallon cage buster tote, in the amount of \$2,734.50. This is needed to spray right-of ways with. He will be needing other equipment from Agro Chem, Inc. for spraying and is requesting permission to spend up to \$10,000 for this.
